#### BRILLIANT CITIZENS - Cavendish's star of the screen!

Scarlett plays Sophie Fox in Hollyoaks which airs on Channel 4 and E4 every weekday. She plays the daughter of Sienna Blake & Warren Fox and has been cast as one of their twins (Sophie & Sebastian).

Scarlett was put forward for the role by The Drama Mob, who are a Drama School and Talent agency who run classes in Didsbury. She auditioned against lots of other children from Manchester and was luckily picked for the role. She has currently been playing Sophie Fox for just over a year and loves her on set days which can be long with very early starts. The set is in Liverpool so some mornings we are up and out for 6.30 to be ready and on set for 8!

The role involves taking directions from multiple people including the director, assistant directors & camera men and women. She also has to follow instructions, learn lines, take cues from other actors, ad lib (when required), remember not to look at the camera (which is very hard!) and adapt quickly as things on set can be constantly changed. Scarlett is about to be involved in a storyline which has a run of episodes airing throughout March (2<sup>nd</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> then up to around 22<sup>nd</sup>) as part of a storyline linked
