

You will need to sign up for an MCRactive Go account https://www.mcractive.com/ (sign in) to book free Summer Holiday activities. Once signed up, log into your account - Find Activities - Search by Category 'MCR Holiday Activity'.

You can also visit https://loadstodo.co.uk/ to view additional FREE holiday activities and other opportunities taking place across the city.

Please note that the system will only show sessions 6 weeks in advance, so you may need to log back in at a later date to make further bookings.

If you book a space and your child can no longer attend, please cancel your space as far in advance as possible, to allow the opportunity for another child to take their space at the activity and free meal.
