And Caterpillars received ten class compliments and were rewarded with a pyjama movie afternoon!












Year 4


Year 6

Spanish and then translating them.












Year 3


The children have been working extremely hard in maths using apparatus to solve






In design technology, our topic has been 'Seasonal Eating'. We have been busy exploring fruits and vegetables from around the word as well discovering which fruits and vegetables grow each season in Britain. The children designed and made their own vegetable tart using produce from a range of seasons grown in the UK.

The children have started their Spanish lessons! They have really enjoyed it so far. They are always very enthusiastic and have had lots of fun learning Spanish greetings and numbers to 10! We are very impressed with their progress.











Year 5

In Year 5 we made 'Doodlers' in design technology! We designed our own doodlers and then investigated the best ways to make one, how to keep it sturdy and how to ensure the circuit ensured the motor spun. The doodlers created patterns on the paper.

In writing, we have been reading the book 'Queen of the Falls' and learning about the daredevil feat of Annie Edson Taylor. We have put ourselves in her shoes and thought about the journey down Niagara Falls. We have written in first person and thought about how fronted adverbials and conjunctions make our writing more interesting for the reader.

In science, we have been investigating air resistance and how to help an egg defeat gravity! We learnt that the larger the parachute, the slower it would fall as there was more surface area for the air resistance to act upon. Some of the smaller parachutes fell so quickly the eggs were smashed, whereas the larger parachutes saved our eggs!







Year 1

This half-term, the children in Year 1 have enjoyed learning, we have been incredibly busy in all lessons. This half term in maths, we have been learning place value and addition and subtraction. The children have been showing their calculations with cubes, part-part whole models, tens frames and bar models.





In science, we have been learning all about our bodies and learning about the 5 different senses and what they all mean. The year 1 scientist explored taste and learned that we can taste 5 main flavours: sweet, sour, bitter, salty, and umami. We have done lots of investigations this half term, including learning all about height and if the oldest person is also the tallest! We have also been outside on a nature walk around the field to find signs of autumn, all the children loved it!



In history, we have been learning about toys over time. The children have looked at toys from the 1950s, 1980s, and 2020s. They have found it very interesting looking at toys in the past compared to the present. They also all got to bring in their favourite toy and tell their classes why it was their favourite.











Year 2

In Year 2 we have had a very busy first half term. In English we have been reading a story called Troll Swap. We have worked hard on writing our own versions using capital letters and full stops. We focused on punctuation, expanded noun phrases and using conjunctions. We also worked hard on our spelling using the Jungle Club Spelling programme. In maths, we have worked on place value, addition and subtraction and multiplication and division. In art, we made our own concertina books. We illustrated them and added characters. As part of our geography topic, we also went on a trip into Manchester. We looked at the key features of a city and found some important buildings (town Hall, library, cathedral) as well.
